

Welcome to KIN BEES! We know you will be excited to get into the apiary but first some important information about your experience and the bees.

We have a high demand for our courses and put a lot of energy into organising them so that everyone involved enjoys the day. If you are unable to attend the course after booking and get in touch with us at least 2 days before, we will try to move you to another course date where possible. Beekeeping is totally weather dependent. As we cannot open a hive in wet, cold or windy conditions (this will damage the delicate bees) we will confirm your booking 48 hours in advance. We know moving your experience may be disappointing but we will reschedule you ASAP!

WORKING WITH BEES

The Kin Bees Beekeeping Experience will take you deep inside a beehive and you will handle bees as well as taste their honey. Naturally, bees have a sting and so you will be provided with gloves and a full protective suit with a veil and will be given guidance and assistance to ensure they are properly fitted.

Clothing – joggers or jeans and a sweatshirt or hoodie are advisable for under your bee suit. We also advise wellies or sturdy boots. You may find a baseball cap comfortable under the hood and if you have long hair please tie it back as you will be bending forward and will not be able to open the veil to tuck it back. Its totally fine to wear contacts of glasses under the veil. Please do not wear any perfumes, aftershaves or body sprays. A non or low-scented deodorant and shower gel/soap are also advisable.

We keep good-tempered bees and the risk of stinging is minimal, but in the event that you are stung, we will take action to limit the effect and ensure you are able to enjoy the rest of the session. If you know that you suffer a reaction or are allergic to bee stings, please contact us to discuss the matter before booking. Allergy to a bee sting is rare and a short-term reaction is normal.

If at any time you feel uncomfortable please let the beekeeper know and we can take some time out.

Tea, coffee, water and honey cookies are provided.

Whilst all efforts are made to safeguard our delegates from such dangers, accidents and injuries can happen. In agreeing to take part in this activity, you are acknowledging these dangers and agree to take part at your own discretion.
