Installation

We will install beehives at our agreed location with a colony of bees in each. Dayto-day management will commence immediately after installation. Please note that we recommend a minimum 3-year agreement for continuity.

Colony Management

Beekeeping management encompasses a wide array of responsibilities, including weekly inspections, treatments, hive manipulation, and the addition or removal of wax frames and boxes where necessary. To ensure optimal performance, a minimum of 15 inspections will take place between Easter and the October weekend.



Honey Harvest

Although the yield of honey is never guaranteed, it is a delightful bonus for beekeepers. Our team will carefully remove all of the honey supers and extract each frame by hand. We then store the honey in food-grade tanks and return it to you for personal use or packaged in your own jars (unlabelled). This service is included in the annual colony management cost.
